### INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Township Office. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The name of the inspector and the telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the location and permit number. EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REINSTATED.

### LEAD FREE NOTICE

The State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, requires pipes, pipe fittings, solder or flux, which are used in the installation or repair of a plumbing system in a building or structure, providing water for human consumption or a public water system, be lead free. Lead free is defined as solder or flux containing not more than 0.2% lead; and pipe fittings containing not more than 8% lead. These provisions do not apply to leaded joints necessary for the repair of cast iron pipes.
